Comments

I would have liked if the teacher took more time to develop feedback for those that didn't perform as well in the assignments, I would have taken the chance to learn more from mistakes and apply them in the following assignments.</p>
<p>I find it very disappointing, not because of the difficulty of the assignments and unpleasant grade. But because of how the professor handled the assignment grading. I am unhappy about my grade and I work harder for the second time. But every time we received little attention and feedback of how we could improve our individual work. And the TA is like nonexistent. Coming to class for a few visit to record the attendance and that's all. Even for us who wrote to professor or ta for individual feedback, there is no response. I don't see how we can improve or even understand where we did wrong and how we can act based on the current learning situation. Because what I want is to learn and know where I am good and where I should work harder.</p> <p>If the class or school have limited resources to handle such an important class, then you shouldn't open it at all. I have had economics professor who is wto chief economist. I don't suppose he is less busier than ours. But I have never seen such uncaring behavior towards students.</p> <p>Another thing I noticed that the professor does not keep his words. For people who submitted late for like an hour or so(it is not 5 minutes or 10 minutes ), he did not give any penalty to these students. My intention is not penalize student for their delay but I do not think this kind of loose management will make us respect the class more.</p>
